# Mission & Values

### What are we working on in 2023? We have a big goal to celebrate our 50th anniversary!

Since 1973, Dawn Farm has met our community's needs with compassion, creativity, and hope. We offer a continuum of long-term services to help people achieve long-term recovery. Most importantly, Dawn Farm helps people with addiction build a recovery support system in the community.

#### Core Value: Any addict can get better



To help address this community need, we moved our Outpatient office closer to Ypsilanti, strengthened connections with the local recovering community, and expanded Recovery is Good Business relationships in Ypsilanti. We also started renting a small apartment building on Miami Avenue, and developed a community of Dawn Farm Transitional Housing there.

## How You Can Help

To celebrate the 50th anniversary of Dawn Farm, we plan to purchase a permanent Dawn Farm Transitional Housing location in Ypsilanti, ideally the Miami Avenue location. Our goal is to fundraise at least \$500,000 over the next few months. Will you help us?

We are committed to building and sustaining permanent recovery-supportive services in Ypsilanti. We are in year four of a five year lease at Miami Avenue. The current owner is planning to sell, and we risk losing this location and displacing the residents who live there.
